A Ph.D. in Criminology, Criminal Justice, or related social science field (e.g., Justice Studies, Public Policy, Sociology) is required by the time of appointment. ABDs with a clear timetable for completion prior to the start of employment will be considered. A J.D. alone is not sufficient for this position. Successful candidacy requires eligibility to work in the United States and the satisfactory completion of a criminal background check.

The Department of Sociology, Criminology, and Social Work offers majors in Criminology, Sociology, and Social Work, as well as minors in Criminology, Sociology, and Anthropology. Area of specialization for this position is open, although preference will be given to candidates whose teaching interests supplement existing strengths within the Department and serve multiple programmatic needs. Applicants should demonstrate excellence or the potential for excellence in teaching and an active and clear research agenda.

Review of applications will begin November 1 and continue until the position is filled. Applicants for the position should submit a cover letter, statement of teaching and research interests, current curriculum vitae, and a list of at least three references electronically to Dr. Christopher Williams, Director of Criminology, at crmsearch@fsmail.bradley.edu. Information regarding how the candidate can contribute to diversity in teaching, research, or service should be provided either within the aforementioned documents or in a stand-alone diversity statement.
