



### **Assistant Professor of Sociology**

Coastal Carolina University invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor in Sociology to begin in the fall of 2019. Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Sociology with a concentration in criminology by the time of their appointment. The successful candidate must be able to teach classes in our Criminology concentration, such as Criminological Theory, Juvenile Delinquency, Deviant Behavior, Policing, Corrections, Victimology, and Law and Society. Scholars specializing in feminist and critical criminology are encouraged to apply. The ideal candidate would also be able to support one or more of our areas of concentration aside from Criminology: Medicine and Health, and/or Social Justice.
