Position: Resident Assistant Professor

Position Summary:

Creighton University's Department of Cultural and Social Studies invites applications for a non-tenure-track resident assistant professor position in criminal justice. This is a one-year position, which may be renewed for up to 3 years. The position begins in the Fall of 2018. Candidates should be comfortable with teaching criminal justice courses required for the Sociology - Criminal Justice Policy Track major, but also taken as electives by students outside the major. The Resident Assistant Professor will teach a 4-4 course load or equivalent beginning in August 2018. Candidates should hold a terminal degree in Criminal Justice or Sociology or closely related field with a Criminal Justice emphasis, or have a Master's degree and teaching experience in the areas of Criminal Justice or closely related field with a Criminal Justice emphasis.

- Three letters of recommendation, at least two of which speak of the candidate's teaching ability
