Assistant Professor in Criminology

The Department of Sociology and Anthropology at Eastern Illinois University invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor position in Criminology to begin August 2018. A Ph.D. in Sociology or Criminology at time of appointment is preferred, but ABD applicants will be considered. We are seeking candidates with teaching and research experience in Criminology who can teach existing courses in the department, as well as develop new courses for the recently launched Criminology and Criminal Justice major. Special consideration may be given to candidates who can teach courses in criminological theory, juvenile delinquency, and/or other courses that complement current departmental offerings. Candidates must be committed to excellence in undergraduate teaching, service to the discipline/university, and demonstrate potential for research and publication. Demonstrated commitment to diversity and experience with promoting inclusive excellence is required.
