

Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice-Criminology

Lycoming College invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Criminal Justice-Criminology beginning in Fall 2019. Successful candidates must have a commitment to excellence in undergraduate teaching and a dedication to the value of a liberal arts education. Candidates should have a desire to work within a small department, where there is considerable potential to impact the direction of the curriculum and experiences offered to students. Area of research expertise is open and candidates will have the opportunity to teach courses in their specialty as well as teaching core courses in the curriculum as part of the 3/3 teaching load. The department has strong connections with local, county and federal criminal justice agencies in the area, so significant opportunities exist for research, volunteer and service-learning experiences for faculty and students. PhD in criminal justice and criminology or related disciplines is preferred; however, ABDs who are nearing completion will be considered and are encouraged to apply.

Lycoming College is a four-year, private, residential liberal arts college dedicated to the undergraduate education of 1,300 students. The college has a vibrant residential community and is located in Williamsport, Pennsylvania, a city of approximately 30,000 in the mountains of north central Pennsylvania near the banks of the Susquehanna River, which offers ample opportunities for cultural entertainment and outdoor recreation.
