RESPONSIBILITIES:

Teaching responsibilities could include courses across the program, but will reflect the needs of the department, and may include issues of ethics and diversity in criminal justice, victimology, and courses in the candidate's research area. The successful candidate will be required to act as a student advisor and will be expected to be active in campus and community service.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The successful candidate will possess a Ph.D. in Criminal Justice or Criminology (ABD may be considered). A JD is not considered an appropriate qualification for this position. Although the area of specialization is open, preference will be given to candidates with practical, professional experience in the field of criminal justice.
