**Position Summary:**

The primary area of specialization is open; however, preference will be given to candidates who can contribute to the criminal justice component of our program, for example, sociology of law, legal ethics, health, and social policy. Experience using Geographic Information Systems (GIS) is also highly desirable but not required. The successful candidate will (1) establish and maintain an active research program; (2) teach introduction to sociology and social problems and teach courses in the area of their specialization that will service both sociology and criminal justice students; and (3) participate in the affairs of the department and the mission of the University. **Duties and Responsibilities:**
