

## **Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice**

The Department of Social Sciences at Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) seeks an Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice (tenure-track, 9-month position) to begin Fall 2019. Duties include teaching of undergraduate and online graduate courses. A reduced load (2-2 for the first year) is provided to allow for other duties, such as performing/publishing research in criminal justice or closely related areas, and serving on departmental, University, and professional committees.

### **Required Qualifications:**

The successful candidate must hold an earned doctorate in Criminal Justice or related fields. ABDs will also be considered but must have earned a doctorate before appointment. All specializations (for example, but not limited to, policing, courts/legal, corrections, research methods/statistics, and administration) will be considered.

We desire candidates who: demonstrate strong research skills, have a strong record of or potential for sustained publication in peer-reviewed journals (commensurate with experience), have the potential for or prior experience with seeking and/or securing external grant funding, work with diverse student populations, and have the ability to teach in areas that complement or strengthen our undergraduate and online graduate programs.

TAMIU is a growing university of over 7,500 students located in Laredo, Texas, a vibrant bilingual, bi-cultural city with a population of about 250,000 on the U.S./Mexico border. Normal course load for junior faculty is 3 courses per semester, although we offer opportunities for course release. Additional pay is available for summer teaching.
