

## **Instructor or Assistant Professional of Criminal Justice**

The Department of Social Sciences at Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) seeks an Instructor of Criminal Justice (non-tenure track, 9-month position) or an Assistant Professional of Criminal Justice (non-tenure track 9-month position with the potential for tenure-track) to begin Fall 2019. Duties include teaching of undergraduate and graduate courses, developing and teaching online courses, advising students, and serving on departmental, University, and professional committees.

### **Required Qualifications:**

For the Instructor position, the successful candidate must hold an earned master's degree in Criminal Justice. For the Assistant Professional position, the successful candidate must hold an earned doctorate degree in Criminal Justice or related fields. ABDs will be considered for the Assistant Professional position but candidates must have earned a doctorate before appointment. All specializations (for example, but not limited to, policing, courts/legal, corrections, research methods/statistics, and administration) will be considered.
