Criminal Justice & Criminology at the University of Central Missouri (UCM) is searching for two (2) Assistant Professor Tenure Track appointments. UCM is a public regional comprehensive institution with one of the oldest and most respected Criminal Justice programs in the nation. Located in Warrensburg, Missouri, the campus is about 30 minutes from the metropolitan Kansas City area. The Department of Criminal Justice currently has 14 full time faculty positions with approximately 700 undergraduate majors and 80 graduate students.

This position requires online as well as face-to-face teaching, participating in appropriate academic service and involvement in professional and scholarly development activities. Anticipated date of appointment for is August, 2018.

Generalist (Assistant Professor/Tenure Track #998480 and #998482). Minimum requirements include the ability to teach courses in the area of Criminal Justice & Criminology within the current curriculum and a Ph.D. in Criminal Justice and/or Criminology. ABD candidates with degree to be awarded within six months of appointment will be considered. For a legal scholar, JD with at least one State Bar is preferred. Preferred candidates are those with demonstrable commitment to scholarly and professional activities, the instruction and mentoring of both undergraduate and graduate students, a readiness to participate in departmental, college, and university service, as well as an ability to contribute to distance learning opportunities. Candidates with skills and experience in law enforcement and/or legal studies and/or victimology are highly desired.

UCM requires all faculty applicants for this position complete the on-line faculty profile, including three (3) references with names addresses, phone numbers and e-mail addresses, and submit to the selected position number for review at <https://jobs.ucmo.edu>. Requested documents are (1) a letter of application, (2) curriculum vita, and (3) unofficial transcripts. These documents must be attached to the faculty profile at the time of application. Only completed on-line faculty profiles with attached documents will be accepted for this position. If contacted for an interview, three (3) formal letters of reference and official transcripts for all awarded degrees will be required. The finalist chosen for this position will be subject to criminal background and educational verification checks.
