The Department of Sociology at the University of Iowa seeks applicants for Visiting Assistant Professor (full-time, non-tenure track) to teach courses for our Criminology, Law, and Justice major. The specific courses taught will be negotiated depending on expertise, and may include Introduction to Criminal Justice; Policing and Society; Juvenile Delinquency; American Crime; Community Corrections; White Collar Crime; Race, Crime & Justice; Women & Crime, as well as other possibilities. The position is a one-year appointment. The teaching load is three courses per semester. This position will be an integral part of the Department's efforts to expand our offerings in criminology and criminal justice. A PhD in Sociology (with an emphasis on criminology/criminal justice) or a Ph.D. in Criminology and Criminal Justice and a record of high quality research are required. Prior teaching experience is desired. The position will begin in August 15, 2018; the appointment requires that a Ph.D. be received by start of the appointment.

Applicants should provide a letter of interest, a curriculum vitae, writing samples, teaching evaluations, a set of syllabi and other teaching materials, and three professional letters of reference. The review of applicants will begin on January 10th and will continue until the position is filled.
