

The Department of Sociology invites application for a full-time tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor for an August 2019 appointment. The successful candidate will be expected to regularly teach criminology courses in the department's BA and MA programs in Sociology. Area of specialization is open but candidates who can enrich or expand existing faculty expertise are preferred. Faculty in Sociology typically carry an annual five course load. Applicants must demonstrate promise of distinguished scholarship and excellence in teaching, as well as a commitment to seeking external funding. Candidates must hold or anticipate a Ph. D. in Sociology by August 1, 2019. Candidates for whom the Ph. D. has not been conferred as of August 1, 2019 will be considered for an initial appointment at the rank of non-tenure track Instructor.
