The Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice at the University of Northern Colorado is seeking a contract-renewable (non-tenure-track) Assistant Professor (Ph.D. expected), instructor (Ph.D. expected), or lecturer (M.A. expected) to start in August of 2019. A Ph.D. or M.A. in Criminal Justice, Criminology, Sociology, or a related field is expected. The workload distribution for the position will be commensurate with rank (3-3 teaching load for CR Asst Prof; 4-4 for instructor or lecturer). The successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate potential for teaching excellence at the university level in traditional and online settings, developing and maintaining an active research agenda (including juried publications and grant writing), and participating in service activities (such as departmental, college, and university committee work and program evaluation, and participation in professional organizations). Preference will be given to applicants with research and teaching interests in: policing, victim studies, and criminology. Applicants should possess personal and professional commitment to diversity as demonstrated by involvement in teaching, research, and service to the profession. The ability to teach both undergraduate and graduate level classes is expected. Salary: Commensurate with experience.

The university is a research intensive institution enrolling 13,000+ graduate and undergraduate students.
