Job Description: The Department of Criminal Justice at the University of North Texas (UNT) invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor (tenure-track) in Criminal Justice, beginning Fall 2019.

Qualifications: A Ph.D. in Criminal Justice or a related field at the time of appointment is required along with a demonstrated ability to teach a variety of criminal justice courses at both the undergraduate and/or graduate level. A demonstrated and a defined research agenda is required, along with a record of peer reviewed publications. Experience developing and teaching online criminal justice courses is preferred. A research background in policing is also preferred. A J.D. (Law) degree alone is not an appropriate degree for this position.

Responsibilities: Candidates for this position will be expected to teach a range of criminal justice courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels, continue a demonstrated and defined record of scholarly research, and contribute service to the department, the College of Health and Public Service, and the University of North Texas.

The University: The University of North Texas is a student-centered research institution with over 37,000 students. UNT is conveniently located within the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex. The Department of Criminal Justice currently enrolls over 700 undergraduate majors and 60 graduate students.

Application Procedures: Applicants for the Assistant Professor position must send a cover letter and application with information that details the applicant's teaching experience and teaching philosophy, and research interests and qualifications, relative to the required qualifications of this position. In addition, applications must include a curriculum vita, and contact information (name, address, telephone number and e-mail address) for five references. Review of applications will begin as soon as possible and will continue until the search is closed.
