

The Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice in the College of Social Sciences, Mathematics and Education at The University of Tampa is seeking applicants for a one-year renewable, non-tenure eligible Assistant Professor position beginning in August 2018.

The University of Tampa is a medium-sized, comprehensive, residentially-based private institution of 8,913 undergraduate and graduate students. The University is ideally situated on a beautiful 110-acre campus next to the Hillsborough River, adjacent to Tampa's dynamic central business district, which is a growing, vibrant, diverse metropolitan area. UT reflects this vibrancy; with 20 consecutive years of enrollment growth UT boasts 229 student organizations, a multicultural student body from 50 states and 140 countries, and "Top Tier" ranking in *U.S. News & World Report*.

The department is primarily seeking a generalist in criminology/criminal justice. The successful candidate must have demonstrated experience in teaching Introduction to Criminology and Introduction to Criminal Justice. Other areas of teaching are open. Similarly, since this is primarily a teaching position the specific area of scholarship is open.

Term faculty members are expected to teach 4 sections per semester (fall and spring) of primarily lower-division courses in Criminology and Criminal Justice. Term faculty members are also expected to attend department and college meetings and provide a commensurate level of service to the department and the college as needed.

Screening of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.

Ideally, the successful candidate will have a Ph.D. in Criminology or Criminal Justice. ABDs will be considered. Related fields or a Juris Doctor will also be considered for this position.
