

The Department of Sociology and Criminology at Valparaiso University invites applications for a **tenure-track Assistant Professor**, to begin in Fall 2019. Ph.D. preferred, but A.B.D. candidates who expect to complete the Ph.D. by Fall 2019 will be considered. The applicant must be able to teach a broad range of criminology courses, including Criminological Theory and the Criminal Justice System. The area of specialization is open, though the Department is particularly interested in candidates who can teach courses in comparative criminology. The University places major emphasis on teaching, in addition to scholarship; preference will be given to persons with teaching experience and evidence of teaching effectiveness.

Valparaiso University is an independent Lutheran university located in northwest Indiana, one hour from Chicago. Valparaiso University does not unlawfully discriminate and aims to employ persons of various backgrounds and experiences to develop and support a diverse community.
