Assistant Professor – Criminal Justice

The Criminal Justice (CJ) Department at Worcester State University invites applications for one tenure-track assistant professor position with a start date for the Fall Semester 2019.

The successful candidate will be able to:

- Teach core courses including Introduction to Criminal Justice, Introduction to Corrections, Theories of Crime, American Judicial System, Law Enforcement and Society, and Research Methods;
- Teach elective and special topics courses within area of expertise
- Participate in student advising;
- Develop new courses for online and face-to-face delivery;
- Provide service to the WSU community through departmental and university-wide committee work; and
- Maintain an active research and scholarship agenda.

Requirements:

Applicants must possess a Ph.D. or other related terminal academic degree in criminal justice or a criminal justice-related field and documented experience teaching in an undergraduate setting to diverse learners. A J.D. alone, or ABD does not meet the requirements.

Specialty in Security Studies, including Cyber-security and Private Security, is highly desirable, as well as is an ability to develop and teach online courses.

Review of applications will begin October 1st and continue until position is filled.
